**Indigenous Food Services Worker**

**Position Overview**

The Indigenous Food Services Worker will coordinate and prepare healthy meals for our agency's programs and services as well as organize and facilitate an Indigenous youth cooking program, which will include:

- Promoting the physical, mental, emotional and spiritual wellbeing of our youth between the ages of 16-24.
- Organization and facilitation of an Indigenous Youth Soup Club for a minimum of 4 – 8 participants.
- Promoting food safety, meal planning, budgeting, and nutrition on a low budget; program supply planning and shopping; and delivery of Soup Club sessions.
- Program coordination, youth engagement, and record keeping.

**Required Education, Skills and Abilities**

- Demonstrated completion of a professional training program diploma/certificate in the food services industry
- Proven work experience as a coordinator in the food-related sector.
- Experience with facilitation and demonstrated ability to develop strong, positive relationships with youth and young adults.
- Possess Food Safe and have a combination of related experience and education.
- Excellent understanding of various cooking methods, ingredients, equipment and procedures.
- First Aid certification is an asset.
- Have knowledge of food security and safety issues, and possess an ability to work with minimal supervision.
- Demonstrated ability to work independently, within budget and time constraints.
- Successful applicant must have a valid BC driver's license and reliable vehicle.
- Successful applicant must pass a criminal record review.
