

What Are We Worried About?	What's Working Well?	What needs to happen?
Past Harm Current information – Police report they arrested both mom and dad after the one of the kids called 911 because mom and dad were in a fight. When police got to the house mom was what they described was uncontrollable yelling and screaming. The kids told police that mom and dad were arguing and mom wouldn't let dad leave the house and grabbed him by the neck. Both boys said they saw dad put mom on the ground and was holding her down try to get a ring off her finger. Kids told police that they are scared that their dad will or could kill their mom. Police say dad was calmer but mom really good upset when they arrived. They couldn't calm mom down and were initially going to arrest just dad based on what the kids said but mom was out of control and as a result the arrested both parents. History – there are 2 other incidents (within the last 13 months) that we know of from the history review of dad hurting mom in the home. The first incident one of the boys Matt got slammed into a wall trying to intervene. The second incident (worst incident) David got a black eye after dad hit him when he was trying to stop him from going after mom. We were involved dad completed anger management courses and we closed the case. There is a note that dad does not have any access to his other children because of a history of hurting their mom. This history is from another province. The seriousness of that history is unknown.	Existing Strengths Police shared that the boys despite their upset looked like they were well looked after. Both parents were quite remorseful towards the kids when they were being taken from the home. Mom was particularly upset telling the boys she was really sorry. Existing Safety Current Safety (Immediate Safety) Mom's mom (maternal grandmother) came to the home and got the boys. Grandmother says she will be able to care for the boys in the short term until things can get sorted when mom and dad get released from Jail.	Safety Goal To be sorted – by the assessor – however given this is the 3rd incident might need to look at Informed safety network Safety plan (longer term) for the kids to be in a safe home free from violence Next Steps Meet with grandma and kids. 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Immediate Safety

Thinking about how safe these children are right now – on a scale of 0–10 where 10 is while I do have some worries about them, I don't think they will be seriously hurt today or in the immediate future and 0 means I am really really worried, that those children will be seriously hurt or could die in the coming days or weeks where would you rate the current safety of the child/ren between that 0 and that 10?

Context

On a scale of 0–10 thinking about what you know and have seen about these parents and their care of the children where 10 is this family has some struggles but really, all things considered no more struggles and problems than most other families face in looking after children and 0 is this family is really dealing with some hard issues and concerns and they need supporting and help sorting things out so that these children aren't hurt, scared or going without, where would you scale where things are today?

Screeners scaling in consultation

Immediate Safety – 8 –

Rationale – the boys are both with grandmother. Grandmother has said she will be caring for the boys till things can be sorted for further safety for when mom and dad are released from jail. The boys ages and they have also demonstrated that they will call for help if scared, worried or afraid for themselves or someone else.

Context – 3

Rationale – This has been the 3rd report of concerns in the past 13 months. Although the children were able to call for help this time and try not to intervene when in the past they have gotten hurt in doing the incidents. The safety planning completed with the family has not created the safety needed to prevent further child protection concerns. Further support of safety planning around the violence towards mom by dad is needed for the safety both physically and emotionally for the children given they have shared that they are worried day would/could kill their mom.
