- they may seek independent legal advice at any time about this Safety Plan Agreement;
- their participation to this Safety Plan Agreement is voluntary and they may withdraw their agreement before the End Date, after informing the director in advance of their intention to do so, as agreed above;
- the safety of the children may be re-assessed where party withdraws from this Safety Plan Agreement; and
- there are circumstances in which the child welfare worker may (1) withdraw from this Safety Plan Agreement, at any time, including where the Safety Plan Agreement is no longer adequate to protect the health or safety of the children, and (2) take any other step authorized under the CFCS Act to protect the children.

Reasons for this Safety Plan Agreement (Including child protection concerns)

What factors led to the creation of the agreement? What concerns need to be addressed?

LMO SW is worried that Mom Gabby and Dad Derek have been using drugs like methamphetamines while caring for Jackson and Sarah. LMO worries Gabby isn't able to look after Jackson and Sarah and make sure all their needs are met when she is high on drugs. We are also worried about all the garbage, dirt and rodents living in the family home.

Terms and Conditions of the Safety Plan Agreement

Including, but not limited to, the role of each party and what actions will be taken by each party.

- The parties agree that the information in this Safety Plan Agreement remains confidential unless it is otherwise necessary to use or disclose the information to give effect to this Safety Plan Agreement.
- Sarah and Jackson will live with grandma Linda Cull while LMO completes their assessment. Linda will act as the children's primary caregiver. Gabby and Derek's access to the children will be supervised.
- Gabby, Derek, Linda and the social worker agree that both mom and dad can visit the children, supervised by Linda at Linda's home, during the day time if they are sober and calm. The parents will not spend the night at Linda's home.
- If Linda notices that either parent is agitated, short-tempered, confused, or show other signs of being high before or during the visit with the children, Linda will ask the parents to leave and will notify the social worker.
- If Linda needs any support looking after the children, she will call the social worker, and will also call her brother Johnathon and his wife to help support.
- If for some reason the plan is not followed, or is no longer working to keep the children safe, Linda will inform the social worker, or call After Hours immediately.

- store and protect personal information provided under this Safety Plan Agreement with appropriate security safeguards and inform the child welfare worker immediately if the privacy of the individuals is or may be jeopardized.
